Food Shelf item for June is Pancake Mix & Syrup

Thank you everyone for your continued support !!

June 21 in honor of Father's—RAINBOW OF CARINGNow — and for almost 60 years — Church World Service has been providing emergency relief and long-term sustainable development to people overcoming adversity through its TOOLS & BLANKETS giving program.

A gift of \$172 can buy a Shelter Kit for a displaced family. The kit includes a family-sized tent, ground cover, and four blankets. Just \$20 can buy a set of four Disaster Relief Blankets (tent not included). Field and garden seeds are a gift of \$15; a pushcart or wheelbarrow and hoe, shovel, and rake are \$57. A rabbit hutch and two rabbits is a gift of \$50, while the gift of water in the form of a bicycle with water mount is \$120. And five school desks cost \$50.

You can make cash contributions for as many tools and blankets as you wish. Give them in your own name or in the names of children, friends, relatives or colleagues; **Father's day** then send a gift card to the recipient of your gift, letting them know sustainable help has been given in their name.
